## League Pricing

## The weekly pricing structure is:

## Available Tee Times

- Limited to 108 players each week. 27 tee times Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday utilizing the South, North, and West course.
- Players will be able to select their tee time each week from the following options:
- 6:18, 6:27, 6:36 on the South, North and West courses.


## Weekly Sign-Up

Sign up emails will be sent out on Thursdays at 12:00pm to play the following week. Sign up will close at 12:00pm the day before play. All sign-up emails will come from Golf Genius. Be sure to add to your contacts, noreply 0, golfgenius.com.
You will receive an email with a link to Open Tee Time Registration. Click on the link to view tee times available for the week. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday times will open at the same time.

- You will search for your name in the drop down list, then hit "next".
- Select the day you want to play
- Select the tee time and course
- To add others to your group, click "Register Another Golfer"
- Click "Please Select Player" and start typing in their name (or scroll through the dropdown to find them)
- Players must be registered in the league to be added to a group.


## Ouota System

The quota system will allow us to make a level playing field each week. Instead of strokes, players will mark down scores based on the table below:

| Bogey | 1 Point |
| :---: | :---: |
| Par | 2 Points |
| Birdie | 4 Points |
| Eagle | 8 Points |
| Double Eagle | 16 Points |

If you are not putting for points, you may pick up your ball, record 0 for your score and go to the next hole. After the round has completed, players will add up their points and then post how many over/under ( $+/-$ ) the player is from their starting quota.

Each player's quota will then be adjusted for next week's play based on the information below:

If you shoot +1 , E , or -1 to your quota: Same quota for the next week
If you shoot -2 or lower: Quota lowers by 2 for the next week
If you shoot $+2,+3,+4$ : Quota raises by 2 for the next week
If you shoot $+5,+6,+7$ : Quota raises by 4 for the next week
If you shoot $+8,+9,+10$ or higher: Quota raises by 6 for the next week
The goal is to accumulate as many points over your quota as possible.

## Scoring / Prize Payout

Scorecards are to be turned into the Pro shop immediately following your round.
The player with the most points over their quota wins. We will pay out the top five players (ties will split the payout) of the field each week and that amount will be determined by how many players play.

## League Rules

All USGA rules apply.
In the event of a rainout, an email will be sent to all players. The competition will be canceled regardless of your position on the golf course. Quotas will carry over to the next week without changing. Rainout notifications will be made as soon as possible.

All rulings and disputes will be handled by the Duty Professional. Please call the golf shop (913) 890-1600 and ask to speak to the Duty Professional.

Local Rules:

- For a two stroke penalty, a ball that is lost or out of bounds may be dropped in the fairway within two club-lengths of that fairway edge point, no nearer the hole. Players must estimate the spot where your ball is lost or went out of bounds to use as a reference point.
- Lift, Clean and Place in the General Area will be implemented on days carts are restricted to the path. The golf ball must be placed in the original spot, no closer to the hole.
- All native grass is played as a penalty area, not lost ball.
- The fence on North \#3 is an immovable obstruction. If the fence affects swing, stance, or line of flight, a free drop is granted. Pick up your ball and drop in the nearest drop zone, no closer to the hole. No penalty stroke.


## Pace of Play

Sykes/Lady Overland Park Golf Club promotes a comfortable and fair pace of play that lets all of our players fully enjoy their round of golf. A normal 9 -hole pace will consist of playing the round in 2 hours and 5 minutes or preferably less. Please be aware of your pace and always keep up with the group ahead of you. Ready golf rules should always be observed.

In the event of slow play or any other occurrences that need to be addressed, please call the golf shop immediately (913) 890-1600 and ask to speak to the Duty Golf Professional. We want to make sure that you are completely satisfied with your round after completion and we will handle the situation as soon as possible.
