



VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTIONS:

- ◆ Each Volunteer is asked to report to volunteers table 10 min prior to the start of their shift.
- ◆ Carts may be used when scoring Par 3 if needed.
- ◆ Please do not leave your position until the last group of golfers has finished your assigned hole(s).
- ◆ If at any time, there is a question to ball placement, have golfer play & record 2 balls at the point of question and have course professional resolve issue at the end of play.



REGISTRATION: This person will be stationed in the hitting bay area to check in golfers, confirm and reiterate tee times and give information as needed to the golfer. They will also relay information to the scoreboard about cancellations and withdraws.

PAR 3 SCORER: The Par 3 Scorer is going to be helping the children score all their strokes. We will be giving each player a scorecard and you will need to make sure that it is the correct score. You will be given a score sheet that will need to be turned in at the end of the round. This score sheet is the official scorecard for the group. At the end of play, you will need all players to sign your scorecard and turn it into the tent after the 9 holes have been played. The players can keep their own scorecard. Make sure you read the rules on the score sheet, different rules for each age division.

SCORE CARD COLLECTION: This person collects and verifies the scores of each group/player. Keep the score cards, and a course professional will pick it up.

FORE CADDY: This person sits in a cart and safely helps players locate their hit balls

FLOATER: This person sits in the designated Volunteer waiting area, and waits for an opportunity to open up, if someone does not show up for an assigned duty, you fill in for them. You may also be asked to help the Volunteer Coordinator with any special tasks that need to be taken care of; i.e. emptying trash containers, filling coolers with ice or water bottles, helping direct players to where they need to go.
