League Pricing

The weekly pricing structure is:

Green Fee Per Person	Cart Fee Per Person	Prize Fund	Total Weekly Payment

Available Tee Times

- Limited to the first 84 players each week. 24 players on Mondays and Wednesdays, 36 players on Tuesdays.
- Players will be able to select their tee time each week from the following options:
 - 6:18 or 6:27 Monday - South, North or West
 - 6:09 or 6:18 or 6:27 Tuesday - South, North or West
 - 6:18 or 6:27 Wednesday - South, North or West

Weekly Sign-Up

Sign up emails will be sent out on Thursdays at 12pm to play the following week. Sign up will close at 12:00pm on Sundays. All sign-up emails will come from Golf Genius. You will receive an email with a link to *Open Tee Time Registration*. Click on the link to view tee times available for the week.

- You will search for your name in the drop down list, then hit “next”.
- Select the day you want to play
- Select the tee time and course
- To add others to your group, click "Register Another Golfer"
- Click "Please Select Player" and start typing in their name (or scroll through the dropdown to find them)
 - Players must be registered in the league to be added to a group.

Scoring / Prize Payout

Scorecards are to be turned into the Pro shop immediately following your round or you may take a picture and email the scorecards to Assistant Professional, Jared Way: jared.way@opkansas.org.

Payout percentages depend on how many players play each day. Prize money is paid out every Sunday in credit book winnings that can be used for anything in the golf operations at either Sykes/Lady Overland Park Golf Club or St. Andrews Golf Club.

Quota System

Bogey	1 Point
Par	2 Points
Birdie	4 Points
Eagle	8 Points
Double Eagle	16 Points

After the round has completed, the players will add up their points and then post how many over/under (+/-) the player is from their starting quota.

Each player's quota will then be adjusted for next week's play based on the information below:

If you shoot +1, E, or -1 to your quota: Same quota for the next week

If you shoot -2 or lower: Quota lowers by 2 for the next week

If you shoot +2, +3, +4: Quota rises by 2 for the next week

If you shoot +5, +6, +7: Quota rises by 4 for the next week

If you shoot +8, +9, +10 or higher: Quota rises by 6 for the next week

The goal is to accumulate as many points over your quota as possible.

League Standings

At the end of each week, the player with the most points over their quota will win.

Here is an example of how a scorecard might look at the end of the round:

In the event of a tie, player quotas will still change week to week based on their individual scores, but the player will receive a tie in the weekly prize payouts.

League Rules

Tees

We recommend that each player play the tees that will provide them the chance to be the most competitive on a week-to-week basis. You must stick to the same tees you choose to play on week 1 for the entire season.

Here are the course recommendations based on each players' driving distance:

- Black Tees – 260 yards and above
- Blue Tees – 225 yards to 259 yards
- White Tees – 200 yards to 224 yards
- Gold Tees – 175 yards to 199 yards
- Red Tees – 125 yards to 174 yards

Each player will play their own ball until the ball is holed out. All USGA rules will apply. Each player will be responsible for putting everything out and for playing the ball down.

In the event of a rainout, the competition will be canceled regardless of your position on the golf course. Quotas will carry over to the next week without changing.

The highest score a player can receive on a hole is a double bogey. The hole will end after a double-bogey score is attained, and the player should pick up their ball regardless of location and mark down a hole score of 0.

All rulings and disputes will be handled by the Duty Professional. Please call the golf shop 913-890-1600 and ask to speak to the Duty Professional.

Pace of Play

Sykes/Lady Overland Park Golf Club promotes a comfortable and fair pace of play that lets all of our players fully enjoy their round of golf. A normal 9-hole pace will consist of playing the round in 2 hours and 15 minutes or preferably less. Please be aware of your pace and always keep up with the group ahead of you. Ready golf rules should always be observed.

In the event of slow play or any other occurrences that need to be addressed, please call the golf shop immediately (913) 890-1600 and ask to speak to the Duty Golf Professional. We want to make sure that you are completely satisfied with your round after completion and we will handle the situation as soon as possible.
