GENERAL INFORMATION FOR LEAGUE PLAY

ADULT PAR 3 PLAYER GUIDELINES FOR SIGNING UP TO PLAY

SIGNING UP TO PLAY – An email will be sent out every Wednesday at around 2:00 PM with the Golf Genius link needed to sign up for the following week. Please keep the confirmation email, because has the link you need if you want to make changes. Should you need to change or cancel after 5:00 P.M. on Tuesday or the morning of play, please contact the Sykes Lady OP Pro Shop @913-890-1600.

The league has luncheons after each of the two tournaments. If you intend to attend the luncheon or play in the tournament, you must sign up in advance on Golf Genius. An email sent to everyone starts the signup process a few weeks before the tournament. This is done because we must have a final count for the luncheon & the tournament a week before the tournament. When you sign up for the luncheon, you must pay for your lunch by Venmo or a check payable to “OP Par 3 Golf” by the stated deadline. No refunds, no exceptions.

PLAYING THE GAME

Golf Etiquette

Unlike many sports, golf is played for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game of golf. (USGA)

- USGA Rules Apply
- Players are expected to know the rules. Lack of knowledge regarding a rule does not exempt the player from incurring appropriate penalties.
- Players are entitled to free relief from a burrowing animal hole, a cart path, and a tree, which has been staked or casual water. The player should determine the nearest point of relief.
- No practicing on the golf course or on the putting green of the hole already played, during league play.

- AT THE GOLF COURSE
 - ◆ Be at the golf course **20 minutes** prior to your tee time.
 - ◆ Check in at the first Tee Box, **10 minutes** prior to your tee time.
- ON THE TEE BOX
 - ◆ DO NOT pull golf carts onto the tee box.
- IN THE FAIRWAY
 - ◆ Safety First
 - Know where the other players are on the hole or the course (you are responsible for ensuring that your intended landing area or line of play is clear of other players)
 - ◆ Avoid damaging the course
 - Repair divots (dirt side down and step on the divot to ensure flatness)
 - ◆ Place your cart, either pull cart or riding cart, so that it is out of players' line of vision
- IN A BUNKER
 - ◆ Enter and Exit on the low side of the bunker
 - ◆ Rake your footprints from the bunker
 - ◆ Place rakes on the outside of the bunker, parallel with the line of play
- ON THE GREEN
 - ◆ Repair your ball mark
 - ◆ Avoid damaging the green
 - ◆ Don't stand on another player's line when putting
 - ◆ Remove ball from hole by using your hand, not a club
 - ◆ Take turns returning the flagstick to the hole
 - ◆ Replace flagstick so it is centered in the hole
 - ◆ Don't talk when someone is putting

- ◆ Don't walk or cast your shadow on another player's line of putt
- ◆ Don't stand opposite the line of putts
- ◆ Mark your ball by placing the ball mark behind the ball
- ◆ Carts are never allowed on the greens.

READY GOLF

READY GOLF MEANS:

- Be ready at the First Tee Box early & be ready to play.
- Tee off when ready -- no honors. Be sure those playing ahead of you are finished playing that hole and have left the green. ***Exception: On holes 2, 4, 5 & 9 (each one is 135 yards or more) you may tee off while the group ahead of you is on the green, as long as you do not believe that you can hit the green with your tee shot.***
- Be ready to hit when it is your turn
- Hit when ready in the fairway
- Putt out when ready -- no honors, continue putting, if appropriate, until holed out.
- **Record scores at the next tee.**

WALK-ONS -- If you **had not** previously signed up for the play date and you find that you can play, call the pro shop (913-890-1600) to see if there are any openings.

SCORE CARDS – Players pick up a scorecard, when you pay your green fee. **Print your first and last name at the top of the card, along with the date.** Keep track of your individual scores and putts for each hole. ***Update your scorecard at the next tee.*** At the end of play, total both your scores and number of putts, then sign it and get another player to attest to your scores. Add any information regarding the weekly game on the card. Then place your completed score card in the basket located in the Pro Shop, which is in the northeast corner of the pro shop.

PRIZES & AWARDS

WEEKLY EVENTS

We have a wide variety of weekly events to ensure both fun and challenging play for a variety of skill levels. Please refer to the calendar of events to see what the game is for the week. A reminder of the weekly event will be emailed before the day of play **along with results from the previous week**. Turn your scorecard into the basket in the northeast corner of the pro shop at the completion of your game.

Event winner will receive \$5.

This year we will have a birdie day and chip in day once a month. Prizes for these will be \$5.

A hole in One will receive \$50.

Winners will receive a credit to their account for the amount won in the pro-shop to use towards greens fees, merchandise or in Club 27.

TOURNAMENTS

The OP Par 3 league hosts 2 tournaments each season followed by a luncheon on the Sykes/Lady lower patio.

June 19 - Tournament followed by luncheon at Sykes/Lady.

Oct 9 - Tournament followed by luncheon at Sykes/Lady.

First place will pay \$20 to each player, second place will pay \$15 to each player and third place will pay \$10 to each player. The special holes pay \$10 to each of the two winners of each hole.

Registration will be limited to 72 players. A waitlist will be kept.
